

CONTRIBUTIONS FOR STUDENTS WHO ENROLL TO FIRST YEAR MAGISTERIAL DEGREE AND TWO-YEAR SECOND LEVEL SPECIALIZATION COURSES

The Public Tender (www.ardiss.fvg.it/contenuti.php?view=page&id=41#scheda503) for reducing enrolment fees to first year **magisterial degree** courses (two-year course) of the Universities whose legal seat is in Friuli Venezia Giulia and towards the first year of the **two-year second level specialization** courses at the “G. Tartini” Conservatory in Trieste and “J. Tomadini” Conservatory in Udine, is available.

Contribution Sum:

The maximum contribution destined amounts to **euro 650,00** and is determined by an ISEE below or equal to 35.000,00 euro.

In no circumstances can the contribution sum exceed the amount paid by the student for the item of taxes and university fees for enrolling to the first year of the magisterial degree course,

Students exempted for whatever reason from paying the university's taxes and fees are excluded from the possibility of receiving tax reduction benefits.

Benefit Subjects:

Students enrolled in the A.Y. 2017/18 to the first year of Magisterial Degree courses (two-year courses) at the “Università degli Studi di Trieste” and Università degli Studi di Udine or enrolled to the first year of the two-year second level specialization courses at the Conservatories in the Friuli Venezia Giulia regione.

Deadline:

The application must be filled-out before 13.00 hr. date 20th April 2018.

Merits Required:

The student must have achieved his/her first level degree with **marks no lower than 100/110**.

Enrollment Requirements:

The student must result regularly enrolled to the first year of a Magisterial Degree course (two-year) at the University or to the first year of the two-year second level Conservatory's specialization course for the 2017/18 A.Y. and be up-to-date with the University's tax and fees due on day April 30, 2018. Students who change or abandon their studies before July 1, 2018 will lose the right to the benefit.

Income Requirements:

In order to receive the benefits students must have an **Equivalency Indicator of the Economical Situation (ISEE) to Assisted Service for the Right to Higher Education not above € 35.000,00**.

Students who do not have in their possession an ISEE for Services for the Right to Higher Education released by an authorized office (or if a resident in a foreign country by a CAF authorized with Ardiss a list can be found on Ardiss's institutional website.
