

ALLOCATION CRITERIA FOR DESIGNATING HOUSE UNITS AT THE STUDENTS' RESIDENCES LOCATED IN TRIESTE AND GORIZIA FOR THE STUDENTS WHO FULFILL THE ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS ALONE

Procedure for access to an eventual assigning of a house unit to those students who fulfill the enrollment requirement alone are the following:

1. The admission of applications is based on the availability of housing units, the application's submission order, the following categories of subjects have the priority:
 - a. Differently-abled students whose disability percentage is not below 66%;
 - b. Between-Universities' students(Trieste and Udine) who do not fulfill the income and merit requirements for admission to a housing unit grant.
 - c. Enrolled Ph.D. students
 - d. Students acknowledged to Ardiss for having already been a beneficiary to the Students' Residences of Trieste and Gorizia or for being qualified for a housing-unit grant;
2. No student with cohabiting children can be a beneficiary to a housing unit, in as much as the housing-unit designation is strictly personal;
3. The allocation of a housing unit is excluded to the students who face disciplinary measures or have caused damage to Ardiss' property;
4. The temporary lodgings disciplined by other agreements or arrangements, if not used in this case, can be destined to host those subjects mentioned at letters a), b), c) and d).

Although not explicitly provided in the current criteria, reference be made to the Norms on the Students' Residences in Trieste and Palazzo De Bassa in Gorizia.

At the moment, regarding the Students' Residences in Trieste, no lodgings are available and the waiting list presently is long; regarding the Students' residence in Gorizia the lodgings still available will be designated in compliance with the above-mentioned criteria.
